"Is a 30x40 building big enough?"

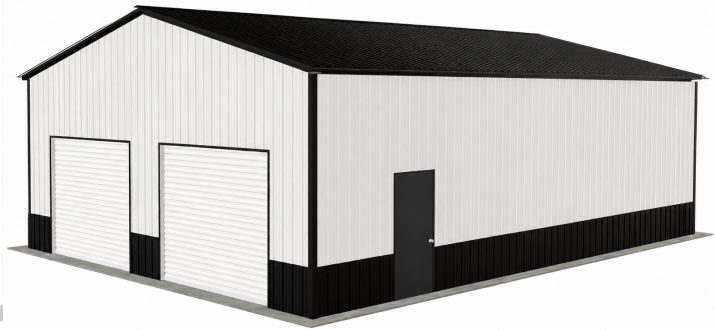
For many homeowners, hobbyists, and small business owners, the answer is yes.

A properly designed 30x40 building often becomes the hub of the property.

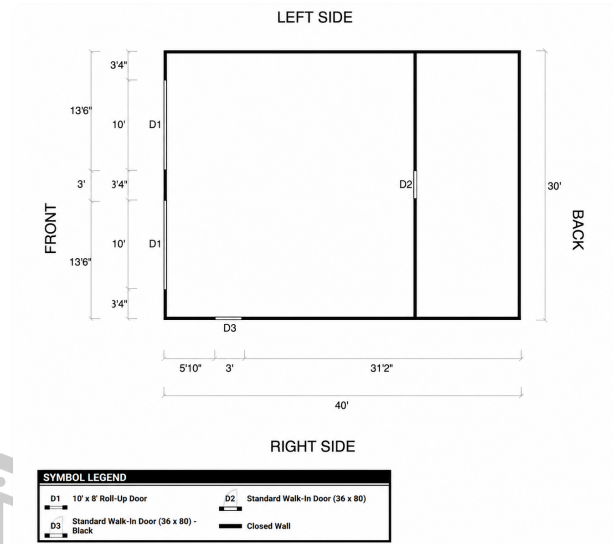
The Popular Combination Layout

Is 30x40 Large Enough for an RV?

It depends on the RV. Many travel trailers and smaller campers can fit inside a 30x40 building if adequate door height and building height are selected. If your primary goal is RV storage, we typically recommend discussing your exact RV dimensions before ordering.

What We Usually Recommend

If you're considering a 30x40 building, we often recommend:

- 12-foot leg height
- At least one 12' x 10' overhead door
- One walk-in door
- A few windows for natural light
- 12-gauge framing for long-term durability

The additional height and larger door provide flexibility for future equipment purchases and changing needs.
